Promoting and reinforcing positive student behaviour and school-wide expectations

Pagewood Public School has the following school-wide rules and expectations expressed through our Learner Qualities:

- 2. Courage
- 3. Collaboration
- 4. Self-Regulation
- 5. Resilience
- 6. Curiosity
- 7. Respect

Pagewood Public School uses the following strategies and systems to explicitly teach, recognise and reinforce positive student behaviour and behavioural expectations:

- Whole school Learner Quality system explicitly taught to staff
- Whole school scope and sequence of the Learner Qualities to be explicitly taught to students
- Learner Quality overview of each Learner Quality
- Emotion Overview, teaching students about emotions
- Explicit teaching of the learner qualities with a stage based program
- Whole school recognition system of the Learner Qualities
- Class merit and whole school honour system including online recognition system (Class Dojos)

Self- directed time-out as part of student's individual planning	Maximum of 10 minutes in different learning space; may leave space to get a drink, attend to bathroom needs	Teacher with supervising teacher in the other learning space	Online monitoring program
Walking and reflecting with a teacher on the playground	Maximum of 10 minutes at a break time	Classroom teacher with playground teacher or playground teacher only	Online monitoring program
Reflection time and restorative practices	Maximum of half a break time	Teacher with assistant principal or principal	Online monitoring program; parent or caregiver informed
