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32 PAGE ST

Attached to this newsletter is a letter from the developers of 32 Page St. It is being distributed to neighbours of the site. The letter gives advice of an information "drop-in" session as well as contact details if you have queries.

As outlined below, there is a little activity. However, it seems that the main work is still a few weeks away from being started. The site remediation contractor, RMA, will be undertaking management actions for the existing stockpiles located on the site surface. Management of these stockpiles is part of recommendation provided by the environmental specialists JBS&G. All identified stockpiles at the site will be covered using a binding layer that forms a crust on the stockpile surface. This crust prevents the generation of dust and infiltration of water through the stockpile surface which could lead to runoff from stockpiled soils. The work will take approximately half a day. RMA will then continue to inspect the site twice a week up until site establishment in late November 2016.

- an entertainment co-ordinator: external performance groups, rides, games & PPS performance groups (this role could then possibly be delegated further) ;

**S Pagewood Development, 32 Page Street**

In September 2016, amended approval was granted to permit the construction of 37 townhouses and 219 residential apartments at 32 Page Street, Pagewood. Visionary Investment Group (VIG) is the developer of the site.

During the development of the site, safety and minimising any risk to the local community, adjacent school, site workers and future residents is of the utmost importance. Given the historical contamination of the site VIG understands that you may have concerns about potential impacts during remediation and construction.

Development consent requires an independent Site Auditor, accredited by the Environment Protection Authority, to review the Remedial Action Plan, Remediation Works Plan and the Air Quality Monitoring Plan. Bayside Council is responsible for ensuring compliance with all aspects of the development consent. VIG is committed to meeting all relevant guidelines and standards.

**Project timing**

The development will take two to three years to complete over stages using specialist contractors and stage programs may overlap. VIG has contracted a site remediation specialist, RMA Group, to undertake the first stage of site remediation. *In November 2016, RMA will commence site establishment works.* Remediation work will start in early-mid December 2016.
