
HEALTH NEWS

HEAD LICE

We have been notified of an occurrence of head lice (nits). To prevent the spread, we ask you to please examine your child's hair thoroughly, preferably in sunlight or very good light and be very aware if they complain of an itchy head or are seen scratching. Children with head lice must be treated before returning to school.

IMPETIGO

We have also been notified of a case of Impetigo in Kindergarten. Impetigo is a contagious skin bacteria infection characterized by inflamed red sores or blisters. A child with Impetigo needs to be kept home until appropriate treatment has begun and the sores covered with a waterproof dressing. Please be alert for any symptoms.



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
