2017 SCHOOL SWIMMING CARNIVAL REMINDER

This will be held on the **second day** of school on **Tuesday 31 January 2017** at Botany Aquatic Centre from 9.30 to 2.30. All students in Years 3 - 6 **next year** will attend. In addition, students in Year 2 **next year** who turn 8 in 2017 and are strong swimmers may elect to participate. This is a great event to get the year under way and parents are welcome to attend. A permission note has already been sent home and this needs to be completed, signed and returned with \$11.50 by **tomorrow**. In the interest of your child's safety, please complete the Swimming Competency form honestly and **initial each section rather than tick**.

TEXT BOOK SALE DAY – ADVANCE NOTICE

On **Thursday 2 February**, a representative from Harpers Books will be here **to supply the textbooks** needed in 2017. Cost for Years 1-6 will be \$53.93. Books for 2017 Kindergarten will cost \$36.94. Payment should be brought by children on the designated day, **Thursday 2nd Feb**, in a clearly marked envelope.

BUDGETING FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL

Each year, a list of Term 1 expenses is published in the last few weeks of the year to assist budgeting for the new school year. The list below is not exhaustive and there may be some minor changes, but should assist some families in their planning.

Please note that any increase in fees is designed only to recover costs. We do not budget to make a profit for any of these activities.

All students:

- Text books will be on sale at the school on Thursday, 2nd February. Kindergarten books will cost \$36.94. Books for Years 1-6 will cost \$53.93.
- The General School Contribution (annual school fees) of \$50 per child will be due in Term 1.
- French/Mandarin: \$60 per child per year.
- Swimming Carnival: (children 8 years and older): \$11.50 for pool entry, pool hire and bus fare.
- Year 5 and 6 overnight camp. Deposit of \$50 will be due in late March. Balance will be due before the excursion dates of 29/30 May.
- K-2: Backyard League/Fundamental Movement Skills 5 week program will cost \$10.

Optional programs:

- Choir: \$40 (approximately) participation fee for Opera House Concert, if our choir is accepted.
- Band fees: \$100.00 per term (or \$370.00 for the year <u>if paid by in full by Tuesday, 21st March.</u>) In addition, there will be an instrument hire fee of \$15 per term, \$60 per year.
- School photos will be taken late on 7th March. A full package of photos is about \$40
- Dance fees will be about \$60 if audition is successful. (Y2-6)
- Y3-6 may try out for the Friday PSSA teams. Bus fare cost is approximately \$50 per term.
- Interrelate Personal Development program will be held on Tuesday evening, 14th March. Cost will be approximately \$35 per family for Years 3-6.
