PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

SOLAR PANEL GRANT

On Friday, I was contacted by our local member, Michael Daley (MP) to announce that Pagewood Public School has received a state government grant for an 85kW solar panel system. It is estimated that this system will be able to provide at least half of the school's electricity needs. I thank the P&C for supporting the school to apply for this grant.

DEMOUNTABLE CLASSROOM - PROPOSAL

In 2019, Pagewood PS will have a 13 class. This will require a demountable classroom to be placed in the school grounds over the Summer holidays. The proposal is to place this classroom where the flag pole and commemorative plaques currently stand. It is proposed that the flag pole and commemorative plaques will be relocated to the front entrance of the school (near the office). Please contact me at Pagewood-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au if you have any comments to make on this proposal. This proposal was raised at the P&C meeting on Tuesday 6 November and parent input was noted. The Grevillea trees and garden beds will be relocated if possible or re-planted.


