As the colder weather approaches us, it is a good idea to purchase winter jumpers and jackets now. A reminder that **winter uniform** will be worn from Monday to Thursday during Terms 2 and 3 and sports uniform on Fridays. As part of correct uniform, all children must wear the correct Pagewood school cap. Navy socks are worn all week. The embroidered sport shorts, should be worn only on Fridays. It is important that shoes are all black on Monday to Friday.

The Uniform Shop opens every second Thursday from 9.15 to 9.45am. Our lovely parent volunteers will open the uniform shop on **Thursday 30 May at 9.15am**.
