The Sydney Region which Pagewood is part of had over ninety teams enter the competition. These schools are then divided into fourteen different zones. The schools Pagewood had to debate against in Zone 9 were Banksmeadow PS, Chifley PS, Malabar PS, Maroubra Bay PS and Mascot PS.

If they are successful they will go onto the Quarter Finals and Semi-Finals as our Year 6 team did last year. A great achievement and we wish them all the very best. *I am a bit worried about the topic they won as the affirmative and look forward to seeing all our teachers participating in the school exercise classes!*

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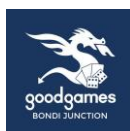
