In preparation for finalising our 2018-2020 School Plan and developing our 2021-2024 Strategic Improvement Plan, staff have been engaged in writing the Situational Analysis and reflecting on student outcomes. We have considered external student achievement through NAPLAN and internal school assessment data. The 'Tell Them From Me' surveys completed by staff, students and parents have been an excellent source of information for reflection. Last week I read to students in class groups (I still have one to go!) and asked them the following questions:

- What does your teacher do that helps you learn best?
- How do you know that your teacher 'knows you'?
- How do you think you learn best?
- What makes you feel like you belong at Pagewood Public School?
- What do you think the school could do to make students feel like they belong here?

I will be emailing our parent community this week to let you know how you can participate in the development of the school's Strategic Improvement Plan. I look forward to your input.

I have been very proud of our Year 6 students this year, they consistently behave appropriately in class and in the playground which has been a steady influence on our younger students at Pagewood during a difficult year. 
