**WELLBEING WEEK**

This is Wellbeing Week and a time to remember to look after ourselves and each other.

**STUDENT WELLBEING FRAMEWORK**

The Australian Student Wellbeing Framework supports schools to give every student a strong foundation so that they can reach their aspirations in learning and in life. The Framework is based on evidence of the strong link between safety, wellbeing and learning.



This week we will look at the Stage 2 Digital Technologies syllabus. In Stage 2 students can develop computational thinking skills in applying abstract thinking to categorise objects, solve problems, design procedures and collect data. Students are introduced to the term 'algorithm', learning that algorithms are also procedures, and use simple coding programs. Examples of learning may include:

- create a dialogue between two sprites in Scratch, eg performing a drama using dialogue from a text or by writing their own
- write an algorithm to solve a simple mathematical problem
- draw 2D shapes using visual coding programs
- research, design and build a solar cooker, then devise an experiment to determine if the solar cooker works, including developing a hypothesis and collecting data to confirm the hypothesis
- construct models that incorporate simple circuits, eg wire and batteries, squishy circuits or Makey Makey – there are numerous sites outlining circuit construction projects,

There are many great learning opportunities happening in our Stage 2 classrooms!

Tomorrow I will be sending the information about how our school community can participate in the planning for our 2021-2024 Strategic Improvement Plan. There will be two Zoom forums as well as a survey. I look forward to your participation and ideas.

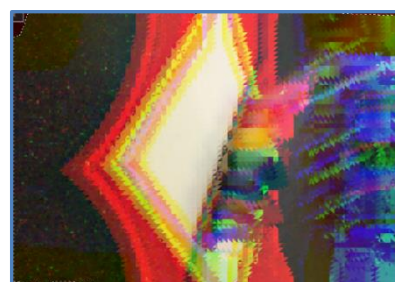

#### FULL DAY PROGRAM!

A full day program is offered with a variety of activities in **addition** to featured incursions and excursions. Programs are displayed daily.

#### How to book

- Visit our website and click on Vacation Care
- Complete the Booking Request Form
- The team will contact you via email to confirm your booking
- If your child has never attended Star Club before, you will need to enrol them first, before we can accept any booking.

#### What to bring

- Morning tea and lunch with accompanying drinks for the day. Breakfast (until 8am) and afternoon tea are provided. Please remember we are a NUT FREE service. Cooking experiences may be held during the day as additional meals.
- Jumper, hat, enclosed shoes, water bottle, spare change of clothes. Children must wear closed shoes but can bring open shoes for suitable activities.
- A big smile!

#### What to do each day

- Drop your child to the gate, please do not walk through the school (due to Covid-19 restrictions).
- Advise staff if your child will be absent by emailing the office
- Adhere to our health policy by keeping unwell children at home.
- Dress your child in comfortable 'play' clothes suitable for active and sometimes messy activities.
- Label all items (clothing, bag, hat, water bottle etc.)
- Notify us of any changes to allergy/health requirements for your child
- Collect your child by 6.00pm to avoid the late pick-up fee of \$15 per 15 minutes or part there of
- Email the office if your authorised contacts/pick-up persons have changed
- Pick up your child at the gate, please do not walk through the school (due to Covid-19 restrictions). There is a sign at the gate with a phone number if the gate is unattended.

#### Weather Conditions

If rain is light, excursions may still be attended. Some activities may be cancelled at late notice if weather conditions are adverse. Families will be notified via email. Alternate activities will be provided if an excursion is cancelled.

#### Daily Activity

Activities may be changed or cancelled at the last minute due to circumstances beyond our control. In this situation, we will endeavour to provide a suitable replacement and notify parents. On days where there is an incursion/excursion option, if minimum numbers are not met for each option, then one may be cancelled and all children will do the same incursion/excursion.

#### Group size & ratio

Anticipated # of children is 40-90 and # of staff is 3-10. Star Club have a 1:15 educator to child ratio and 1:10 for excursions. For exact numbers refer to daily roll and roster on display.

#### Safety, supervision, transport & risk assessments

Star Club have strict safety and supervision procedures and policies, which are available to view onsite or on request. The children are encouraged to actively work with educators to implement these and follow all safety guidelines. Risk assessments have been prepared for all incursions and excursions, including transportation, and are available to view onsite or on request, as is our Covid-19 Risk Management Plan.

#### Behaviour

As per Star Club policy, Star Club reserves the right to exclude a child from the program if they demonstrate repeated unacceptable behaviour or behaviour which may pose a safety risk to others.

#### Money/belongings

Please do not allow your child to bring money, electronic devices, bikes or scooters to vacation care. They may only be brought if specified as part of the program. Star Club and its staff are not responsible for personal possessions if children choose to bring them to the service.

#### Cost & Child Care Subsidy

Daily fees are as listed. Enrolment fees are additional. All daily fees may be discounted through the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) system, if eligible. If it has not been done already, you must submit a Complying Written Agreement for your child(ren)'s Pagewood Public School Xplor profile, then confirm the enrolment in your MyGov/Centrelink account.

#### Payment method

Direct Debit is the ONLY method of payment available. Your Direct Debit information must be updated in your Xplor online account ([home.myxplor.com](http://home.myxplor.com)) before a booking can be confirmed and accounts at all services must be up to date.
