# PAGEWOOD PS DEBATING CHALLENGE WORKSHOP

Debating is an extracurricular activity offered by some Department of Education schools across NSW. It develops the 21<sup>st</sup> Century learning skills of collaboration, critical thinking, communication and creativity. These skills prepare students to successfully navigate the future of their ever-changing world. Pagewood PS entered the Premier's Debating Challenge for Year 5 and 6 students for the first time in 2018. This challenge is conducted by The Arts Unit of the NSW Department of Education. Our present Year 6 team came third overall in this knockout competition in the Sydney Region in 2018 and went on to compete in the 2019 state final as the overall winners of the Sydney Region. They should be extremely proud of their achievements as a team newly involved in debating. During 2020 the competition includes a visit from the department's most senior adjudicators and coaches to conduct workshops in local areas covering all things students need to know in primary debating including rebuttal, arguments, definitions and speakers' roles. In addition, the students play a few relevant games and activities and have the opportunity to give a short debating speech and get some feedback.

The staff at Pagewood PS organised a similar workshop on Monday 30 November 2020 for the entire day to replace The Arts Unit workshops. Year 4 and 5 students that show capable communication and collaboration skills and potential for debating were selected to attend. Our Year 6 debaters participated on the day as group leaders to mentor and coach the younger students. Congratulations to all our students who attended the day and contributed to our successful learning experience.





- Adhere to our health policy by keeping unwell children at home.
- Dress your child in comfortable 'play' clothes suitable for active and sometimes messy activities.
- Label all items (clothing, bag, hat, water bottle etc.)
- Notify us of any changes to allergy/health requirements for your child
- Collect your child by 6.00pm to avoid the late pick-up fee of \$15 per 15 minutes or part there of
- Email the office if your authorised contacts/pick-up persons have changed
- Pick up your child at the gate, please do not walk through the school (due to Covid-19 restrictions). There is a sign at the gate with a phone number if the gate is unattended.

### Weather Conditions

If rain is light, excursions may still be attended. Some activities may be cancelled at late notice if weather conditions are adverse. Families will be notified via email. Alternate activities will be provided if an excursion is cancelled.

#### Daily Activity

Activities may be changed or cancelled at the last minute due to circumstances beyond our control. In this situation, we will endeavour to provide a suitable replacement and notify parents On days where there is an incursion/excursion option, if minimum numbers are not met for each option, then one may be cancelled and all children will do the same incursion/excursion.

# Group size & ratio

Anticipated # of children is 40-90 and # of staff is 3-10. Star Club have a 1:15 educator to child ratio and 1:10 for excursions. For exact numbers refer to daily roll and roster on display.

- If your child has never attended Star Club before, you will need to enrol them first, before we can accept any booking.

# Safety, supervision, transport & risk assessments

Star Club have strict safety and supervision procedures and policies, which are available to view onsite or on request. The children are encouraged to actively work with educators to implement these and follow all safety guidelines. Risk assessments have been prepared for all incursions and excursions, including transportation, and are available to view onsite or on request, as is our Covid-19 Risk Management Plan.

#### Behaviour

As per Star Club policy, Star Club reserves the right to exclude a child from the program if they demonstrate repeated unacceptable behaviour or behaviour which may pose a safety risk to others.

### Money/belongings

Please do not allow your child to bring money, electronic devices, bikes or scooters to vacation care. They may only be brought if specified as part of the program. Star Club and its staff are not responsible for personal possessions if children choose to bring them to the service.

#### Cost & Child Care Subsidy

Daily fees are as listed. Enrolment fees are additional. All daily fees may be discounted through the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) system, if eligible. If it has not been done already, you must submit a Complying Written Agreement for your child(ren)'s Pagewood Public School Xplor profile, then confirm the enrolment in your MyGov/Centrelink account.

# Payment method

Direct Debit is the ONLY method of payment available. Your Direct Debit information must be updated in your Xplor online account (home.myxplor.com) before a booking can be confirmed and accounts at all services must be up to date.
