YEAR 6 - 7 TRANSITION TO HIGH SCHOOL EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FEBRUARY P&C MEETING

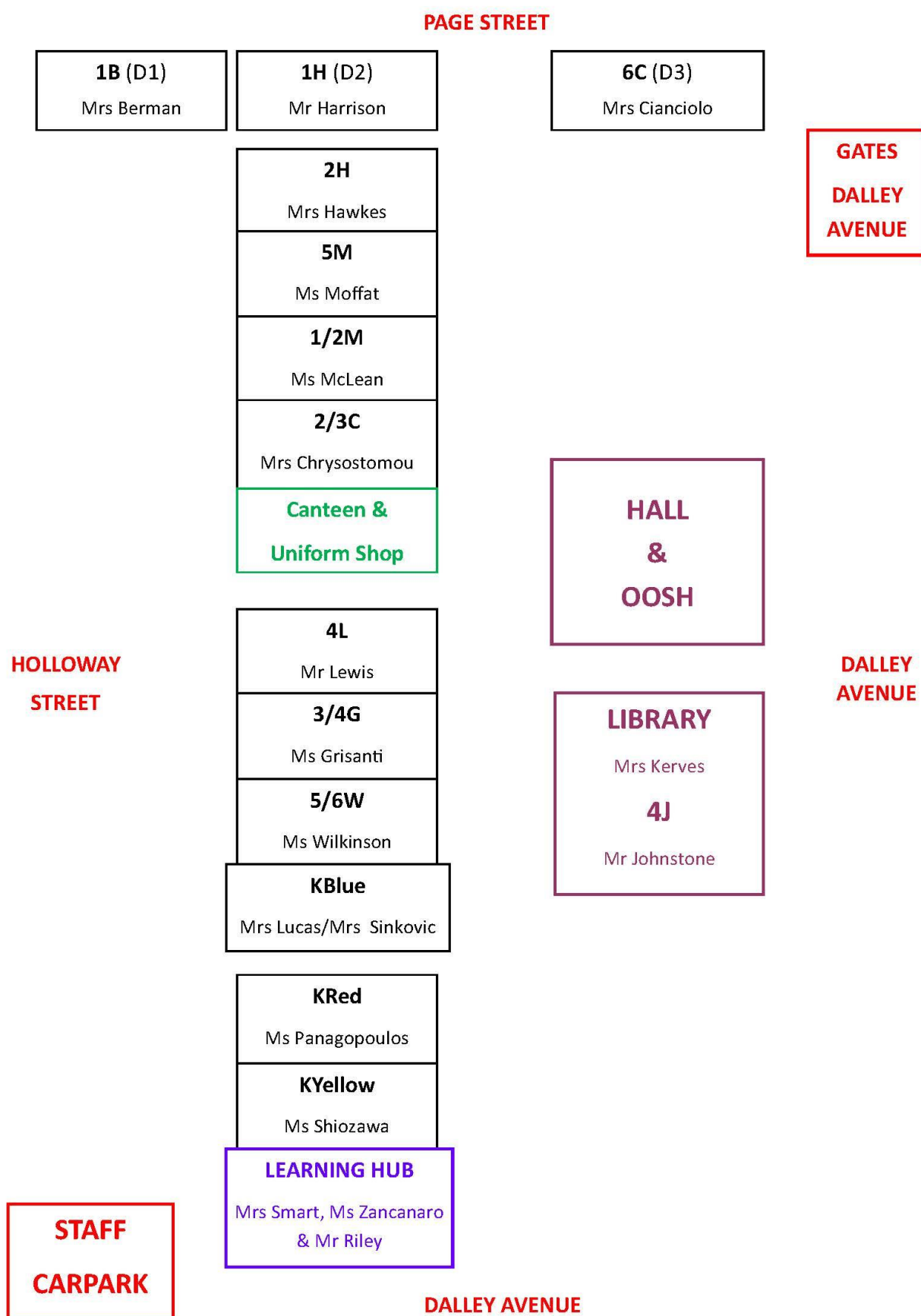
We welcomed lots of new members to P&C. We were busy planning the Welcome Disco and hearing updates on our ongoing projects such as the playground equipment and the solar panels.
