SCHOOL PROCEDURES

There are some very necessary changes implemented at our school which will remain in place to minimize parent/carerer movement throughout the school. Parents/carers are asked to follow the following guidelines:

- Drop off – please drop your child/ren at a gate and leave
- Pick up - Please collect your child/ren and leave. Year 3-6 should be encouraged to meet you at a gate
- K-2 parents should collect their child from the classroom
- Use Kiss and Ride to drop off /collect your child if possible, we will have a teacher there each morning from 8:45am-9:15am and afternoon from 3:15pm-3:30pm
- All parents must report to the office and are NOT to enter school grounds
- Please do NOT enter the classrooms
- Please do NOT chat to your child's teacher. If you have concerns about your child or the learning provided please email or call the school
- This is not the time to hang around at the entry/exit gates or inside the school
- Please do not gather and chat to other parents/carers
- This is not the time to volunteer at school.

OPPORTUNITY CLASS INFORMATION (YEAR 4 INTO YEAR 5 IN 2021)

The 2021 Year 5 opportunity class placement process was put on hold in April 2020 due to the COVID-19 situation. We now have a revised and simplified timeline for the OC placement process to ensure that students and families can have certainty about their placement as soon as possible. The changes include:

- A new date for online applications. Parents must apply between **9 June 2020 and 26 June 2020**. Late applications cannot be accepted.
- A new test date - Wednesday **16 September 2020**.

To ensure fair and consistent assessment of students across New South Wales, students will be offered places based only on their test results this year – there will be no school assessment scores. There will also be no opportunity for appeals given the tight timeframes.

Changes to the opportunity class placement process for Year 5 entry in 2021

Information for parents/carers and students

The department is committed to the continued education of all students across NSW, including advanced learning programs for high potential and gifted students.

The 2021 Year 5 opportunity class placement process was put on hold in April 2020 due to the COVID-19 situation.

We have now rescheduled and streamlined the application process. Please note the details of the changes below and assist parents and carers to understand these changes.

Why have changes been made to the 2020 opportunity class placement process?


Due to the shorter time frame available for the OC placement process, changes have been made to the process for this year. The department is committed to supporting the continuity of learning and transitions for each child, and the revised application and placement process will ensure students are placed in 2021 Year 5 opportunity classes as soon as possible.

What changes have been made?

The 2020 opportunity class placement process has been revised to accommodate the shorter timeline due to the postponement of the test.

To ensure the fair and consistent assessment of students across all schools and regions of NSW, this year students will be placed on test results only. Taking this approach reduces the effect of the disrupted start to the school year, which could compromise school assessment scores, and ensures that all students are placed using the same test performed under the same conditions. The test is created by an independent educational assessment provider and measures academic ability, not achievement, giving a reliable method for identifying highly gifted applicants which is not subject to the variable classroom conditions experienced this year.

2020 Opportunity class placement process - key dates



What are the key dates I should be aware of?

The revised dates are listed below. Parents are advised to review the new dates carefully and ensure an application is submitted by the closing date for their child to be eligible to sit the placement test as, owing to the shorter timeline, late applications will not be accepted.

Road work on Wentworth Avenue, Eastlakes, from Thursday 4 June 2020

Transport for NSW | May 2020

Transport for NSW will be completing concrete and asphalt repairs on Wentworth Avenue, between Bay Street and Bunnerong Road, Eastlakes.

The work will involve up to **34 night shifts** over a **12 week period**, between **4 June and 16 August 2020**. The maintenance work aims to:

- provide a smoother road surface and more consistent driving conditions
- improve the surface of the road, preventing or minimising damage from weather and wear-and-tear
- reduce maintenance costs
- improve road user and public safety.
