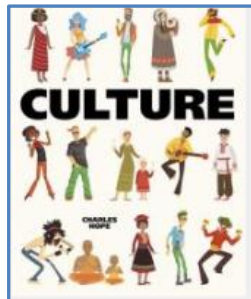

I can now inform you of the outcome of the recent tender to provide an Out of School Hours Care facility at Pagewood. The tender has been awarded to Star Club Pty Ltd. In line with NSW School Infrastructure procurement guidelines the review of applications was made by an evaluation panel which included two parent representatives from the school community and two school representatives. The original start date was set for Monday 20 July, however, I am yet to confirm this in line with Licence Agreement and School Infrastructure requirements. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Bayside Council for the care they have given our students as well as the support provided to Pagewood families. Parent- teacher interviews will take place by telephone in Weeks 9 and 10. Each student brought home a survey for you to complete regarding their learning from home which you should return to school by Friday 19 June. This will form part of the telephone interview conversation. Bookings opened on Tuesday 9 June, see page 4 on how to book. If both parents would like an interview either together or separately please book and let the teacher know.

As we head into the winter months there will be students with flu-like symptoms. If your child has flu-like symptoms please err on the safe side and keep them at home until they have seen the doctor. These measures will ensure that we all stay safe and we can avoid the spread of COVID-19 and keep moving forward. As advised by the Chief Medical Officer, social distancing and washing your hands remain the most effective way to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Social distancing measures will remain in place in schools and I would again like to thank the families who continue to follow our drop off guidelines each morning, your cooperation is much appreciated.
