Students enjoyed our Zoom assembly from their classrooms. Well done to the student leaders who ran the assembly.



Parent- teacher interviews will take place by telephone this week and next week. Each student brought home a survey for you to complete regarding their learning from home which you should have already returned to school. This will form part of the telephone interview conversation.

Welcome to Star Club, the successful tenderer for the Pagewood OSHC service. Their start date is still to be confirmed due to licensing requirements. There is information regarding Star Club services further in the newsletter, including Vacation Care. Whilst they will be providing Vacation Care, this will not be for these coming school holidays. They do provide services at other local schools so you may wish to access these services before they begin at Pagewood PS. They have provided a survey link to gain your feedback and ideas as they begin preparations. I encourage you to provide your feedback.

As we head into the winter months there will be students with flu-like symptoms. If your child has flu-like symptoms please err on the safe side and keep them at home until they are well. These measures will ensure that we all stay safe and we can avoid the spread of COVID-19. As advised by the Chief Medical Officer, social distancing and washing your hands remain the most effective way to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Social distancing measures will remain in place in schools and I would again like to thank the families who continue to follow our drop off guidelines each morning, your cooperation is much appreciated.

A reminder that winter uniform is worn from Monday to Thursday during Term 2 and 3 and sports uniform on Fridays. The embroidered sport shorts or track pants, should be worn only on Fridays. As part of correct uniform, all children must wear the full Pagewood school uniform including jacket and school cap. Navy socks are worn all week. It is important that shoes are all black in colour.

It is not acceptable to wear other kinds of track suit pants. Shorts should not be worn with tights underneath. I know it has been challenging to purchase items onsite this year, please leave orders at the office. The uniform shop will resume opening onsite to parents from Term 3.
