Week 1 has flown past as we get back into the swing of things here at Pagewood PS! K-2 students began gymnastics which looked like a lot of fun and generated lots of excitement for Kindergarten.

We are constantly having to make changes to our plans as we receive updated information from the NSW Department of Education. We have decided to continue with fortnightly K-6 assemblies via Zoom for now. This is working well and allows us to come together as a whole school safely. Thank you for your cooperation following our guidelines here at school.

There are border restrictions in place between NSW and Victoria. Anyone returning from Victoria since 8 July must self-isolate for 14 days from the date of their return to NSW before returning to

school. Any parent who is returning from working in Victoria must not come to the school site.

During the holidays, Jacob, our casual general assistant spent some time working at the school to tidy up our gardens and cut back plants. Thanks Jacob!



Many children are feeling anxious about life in general in

our current circumstances, many adults are feeling the same way. All schools have noticed an increase in students who are concerned about staying healthy as well as the impact of increased time indoors and at home. We are here to support families and work together to ensure all students are feeling safe coming to school and happy to do so.



Pagewood Public School will be engaging with the *Smiling Mind* program this term. Research shows that a whole school approach leads to more positive student outcomes such as optimism (for teachers

and students), social-emotional competence and reduced anxiety for students and teachers. Two staff members are currently being trained as *Smiling Mind Champions* and will lead the program for teachers and students at Pagewood. Ways to build resilience in students was a topic that was raised at a P&C meeting in 2019. We have considered a number of available resources and this is a wonderful program that will suit our school and our needs.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT

Statement of Accounts will be prepared shortly and sent out this week to families in Y3-6 with outstanding expenses.

Our preferred method to pay your child's 'Statement of Account' is for Parents and Carers to use the Parent Online Payment (POP) system. This is to reduce the amount of cash being handled at school by the office, students and staff. To pay by POP, please go to the Pagewood Public School website at <u>http://www.pagewood-</u>

<u>p.schools.nsw.edu.au</u> and select 'Make a payment'. Parents and Carers are welcome to pay for two or more children in one payment. This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner. These details are not passed back to the school.

Please note that this facility is to pay for expenses on your Statement of Account only, it **cannot** be used to pay for the Canteen or P&C costs such as Uniforms or fundraising. Payment instructions are on page 7. When paying by POP you must enter:

- student's first name
- student surname
- class
- Please tick what you are paying for (eg. voluntary contribution, sport, excursion, other, etc)
- \$ Amount
- You DO NOT need the Student Registration Number

If you wish to pay by cash, please send cash payments to your child's teacher on Tuesday only.
