#### **PRINCIPAL'S NEWS**



Many thanks to the SRC for organising and the teachers and students for participating in last week's pyjama day. We raised a generous donation of \$426.50 for the Exodus Foundation, which provides meals and support to the homeless. We have posted some fabulous photos on page 3 for your enjoyment.

I hope parents have enjoyed reading about their child/ren's progress in their reports. Reports give a snapshot of your child/ren's educational journey at a point in time. This year student reports reflect the change to online learning during the learning from home period.

There are some important changes as of today regarding school operations. Students and staff with flu-like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school. Pagewood Public School families should send a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result via email by 9:00am the day their child will return to school after a COVID test. The school email address is pagewood-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Schools are not required to conduct widespread temperature screening or mandate the wearing of a mask.

In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded **NOT** to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu-like symptoms to be sent home. We really appreciate your ongoing cooperation with the drop-off and pick-up systems currently in place. **No parent or carer should be entering the school gates before school.**

#### SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN PLACE TO KEEP US SAFE

There have been a lot of changes to our school routines in order to keep students, staff and our community safe. We have new systems in place to combat this virus, here is a reminder:

- Students and staff with flu-like symptoms to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school. Parents/Carers should email test result to school email at pagewood-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au
- No birthday cakes, small gifts (for a class) or shared food is to be brought to school
- Students are not permitted to share their food with other students at school
- No parent or carer should be entering the school gates before school
- Parents/carers to drop late students to the office and leave. Please do not walk your child to class.
- From Wednesday there will be no more wind instrument lessons until further notice
- Please drop and collect your child/ren at Kiss n Go where possible
- Canteen is only open Wednesday to Friday

#### **BAND**

There has been a directive from the NSW Department of Education restricting the playing of and lessons in wind instruments, these include saxophone, flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone and French Horn. There will be no small group lessons from this Wednesday 19 August. **Ensemble band before school will not go ahead this week.** There will be further advice from Directions in Music as soon as possible.

Dear Parents & Carers.

Pagewood Public School P&C always welcomes new and enthusiastic members to join our team. It is a great way to get involved at the school, as well an opportunity to have your say.

The P&C meets on the first Monday of each month during the school term. Each meeting is announced in the school newsletter and we have about 8-10 meetings each year and everyone is welcome. At our P&C meetings, topics that may be discussed as an example are as follows:

- Updates from the Principal.
- Fundraising initiatives
- · Father's Day/Mother's Day events (and finding volunteers to run them!)
- School programs
- Allocation of P&C funds towards school programs
- Special morning teas or events
- Uniform Shop- run by the P&C onsite at school.
- Market Carnival- bi-annual event

The P&C meetings also provide a forum for parents to be able to raise questions and make suggestions about the school for discussion. The agenda for each meeting is available the week prior.

Once a year at the P&C AGM (the second meeting of the year) the office bearers, or executive - the President, Vice Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer are voted in. To be eligible to vote or take up a position on the executive at the AGM, a member must join at a previous meeting. Membership lasts from one AGM to the next and is currently set at \$1 per year. Financial members have voting rights at the AGM, but also for any issues or decisions that come up throughout the year.

An active P&C is at the heart of a every great school, and we strongly encourage parents to get involved at Pagewood Public School. You can be involved by joining the P&C and attending meetings, volunteering for the various fundraisers or events throughout the year, and by supporting the efforts of the P&C.
