### PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

We have lots happening at Pagewood Public School each and every day! This week Mrs Arthur will be holding auditions to join the choir for Years 4-6; our junior and senior bands will be performing at school and the P&C will run a Mother's Day stall for students to buy gifts on Thursday, prices range from \$3-\$10.

Next week NAPLAN online assessments for Year 3 and 5 students will begin. Year 3 will complete the writing task on paper rather than online. Teachers have been familiarising students with the format. The best preparation students can do is getting a good night's sleep the night before. NAPLAN is a point in time assessment of literacy and numeracy skills. It is very important all students arrive at school on time to ensure they hear all instructions.

Last week saw our SRC participate in a workshop to provide feedback about a new playground to be built at Sir Joseph Banks Park in Botany. The students did a wonderful job talking about the purpose of the playground and what they would like to see in it.



Smoke haze caused by back burning is once again with us. We monitor the levels on these days and all students for whom we have identified asthma as a health concern should come to the library for break times. PE lessons and outdoor learning is also reviewed on a daily basis.

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a point in time assessment of literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life. Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 participate in the annual NAPLAN tests in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. ## ETHICS TEACHER AT PAGWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL

Could you be an ethics teacher for Pagewood Public School? We are seeking volunteers so that we can provide ethics classes for all the families who have requested it for their children.

Ethics teachers receive full training by Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the ethics program. Training consists of either a two day face to face workshop or Online Zoom workshop. Lesson materials are provided. Suitable volunteers have an interest in children's education and development of critical thinking skills and must be available at 9:20am-9:55am Tuesday each week.

In ethics classes, children learn how to think logically, disagree respectfully and support their arguments with evidence, rather than act according to blind habit or peer pressure.

Children discuss topic such as:

- imagining how others feel
- how do we treat living things?
- what is laziness?
- how do we disagree in a respectful way?
- fairness
