COVID RESPONSES

In light of the current NSW restrictions our school continues to follow updated NSWDOE guidelines including:

- Staff and students are not required to wear a face mask while at school. Anyone who wishes to wear their own masks in schools will not be prevented from doing so.
- Wearing a face mask is not mandatory for parents and carers visiting schools.
- Events and gatherings on school sites, such as productions, concerts, speech nights and award presentations are permitted. All attendees, including students, staff and visitors, including parents and carers, must be well and free of any flu-like symptoms. A COVID-19 Safety Plan is required if the event is held indoors with more than 100 external visitors or held outdoors with more than 200 external visitors.
- Singing by audiences is to be avoided. If students are performing in a choir that schools ensure there is a minimum of 5 metres between the choir and audience members.
- Staff and students should not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms should be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.
- Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms are strongly encouraged to get tested and self-isolate until a negative result is received. Location of testing clinics are available via the [NSW government website](#).
- Staff and visitors to schools and offices should maintain 1.5m distance from other people where practicable. Avoid congestion of groups of visitors in specific areas where possible.
- All visitors to a school site must comply with sign-in arrangements for each visit. This includes signing the [school sign-in sheet](#) to acknowledge that they will comply with the [COVID-19 requirements for visitors, contractors and service providers](#). Visitors must also check in using the Service NSW QR code.

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a point in time assessment of literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life. Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 participate in the annual NAPLAN tests in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. Our school will be participating in NAPLAN Online between **11 and 21 May 2021**. If you have any questions about NAPLAN Online, please contact your child's teacher.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT

Your child's Statement of Account will be sent home this week for each family. To pay your child's 'Statement of Account', it is helpful to the school if Parents and Carers use the Parent Online Payment (POP) system. **This is our preferred method of payment** and reduces the amount of cash being handled at school by students and staff. To pay by POP, please go to the Pagewood Public School website at <http://www.pagewood-p.schools.nsw.edu.au> and select 'Make a payment' at the top of the page. Parents and Carers are welcome to pay for two or more children in one payment. Please note that this facility is to pay for expenses on your Statement of Account only, it **cannot** be used to pay for the Canteen or P&C costs such as Uniforms or fundraising. When paying by POP you must enter:

- **Student's first name**
- **Student's surname**
- **class**
- **Please tick** what you are paying for (eg. voluntary contribution, sport, excursion, other, etc)
- **\$ Amount**
- You **DO NOT** need the Student Registration Number

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner. These details are not passed back to the school.

If you wish to pay by cash, please send cash payments to your child's teacher on Monday only.

INFANTS' ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

The Infants' Athletics Carnival will be held on Wednesday 2 June 2021, at school. Students will participate in their age races and a range of fun activities after recess, from 11:25am - 1:00pm. Parents are more than welcome to come and support their children. Students may wear either their sport uniform or house colours, provided their attire is appropriate for running. They must have a hat. Students turning 8 in 2021 have the option of attending the Primary Athletics Carnival, or remaining at school for the Infants' Carnival.

The following information regarding the PSSA Code of Conduct is for parents and carers who attend PSSA games and carnivals. Codes of Behaviour provide a supportive framework which promotes fair play and appropriate behaviour in school sport. These codes apply to players, teachers, coaches, principals, parents, officials and spectators who together provide the environment in which school sport is played. The following Codes apply to school sport at all levels and are designed to highlight:



- The principles of enjoyment, satisfaction and safe play in sport
- That students participate for their own sake and not to fulfil the desires of parents, adult groups or peers
- The encouragement of student participation in sport and, in so doing, contribute to higher levels of health and physical fitness.

PARENTS' CODE

- Encourage your child to always play by the rules.
- If children are interested in sport, encourage them to participate. Refrain from forcing an unwilling child to participate.

- Remember that children participate in organised school sports for their enjoyment and fulfilment, not yours.
- Teach your child that honest effort is as important as winning so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Encourage your child to work towards skill improvement. Never ridicule your child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- Always encourage the principle of good sportsmanship.
- Children learn best by example. Applaud good play by all individuals and all teams.
- Do not publicly question the officials' judgement and never their honesty.
- Appreciate the contribution and commitment of teachers in coaching positions. They give their time and resources to provide sporting activities for your child and deserve your support.
- Have realistic expectations for your child and her or his team. Do not expect more than they can give.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities. Condemn the use of violence in any form.
