


PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

In light of the emergence of more locally acquired cases in Victoria, travellers from Victoria who arrive after 27 May must observe stay at home provisions for a full 7-day period. Schools continue to follow all COVID-19 guidelines, personal hygiene, physical distancing, cleaning and record keeping practices. All students, staff, parents, carers and visitors to a school site must be well and symptom free, comply with sign-in arrangements and maintain a physical distance of 1.5m.

Parent - teacher interviews have been set for Week 10. Teachers will set up a timetable of available spots for you to meet with them about your child. You will need to book your interview online. It is always good to book your meeting early so you can lock in a time that suits you best. ATHLETICS CARNIVALS

This Wednesday is our annual Athletics Carnival for the whole school which will be split into two groups. Infants will participate at school and Years 3-6 will walk to Hensley Athletics Field with their teachers. Students will need to be at school by 9.00am. Please ensure your child/ren wears sunscreen and a hat and bring plenty of food and water for the day. All students may wear their House colour Tshirt to represent their House Group. If you do not know your child/ren's House group, please ask your teacher tomorrow before the carnival. Please have a discussion with your child/ren about the importance of 'having a go' at these special school events, it is about participating and having fun.

INFANTS (K-2)

The Infants' Athletics Carnival will be held this Wednesday 2 June 2021, at school. Students will participate in their age races and a range of fun activities after recess, from **11:25am - 1:00pm**. Students may wear either their sport uniform or House colours, provided their attire is appropriate for running. They must have a hat. Students turning 8 in 2021 have the option of attending the Primary Athletics Carnival, or remaining at school for the Infants' Carnival. Parents and carers are more than welcome to come and support their child/ren but must maintain social distance.



YEAR 3-6 AND YEAR 2's TURNING 8 THIS YEAR

The Y3-6 Athletics Carnival will be held this Wednesday 2 June 2021 at Hensley Athletics Field. All students will walk to the venue with their teachers. **Students will need to be at school by 9.00am** and must have a hat. The canteen will be open at the oval. Parents and carers are permitted to attend the carnival but must maintain social distance.

Over the following weeks, students will be participating in shot put and high jump events at school to coincide with our Athletics Carnival. Objectives

- To help children aged 8-10 years gain an understanding of the structure and functions of the reproductive system in males and females.
- To provide information on conception (describing sexual intercourse, associated with love in the context of a caring relationship), foetal development and birth of a baby.
- . To provide opportunities for parents and children to discuss various aspects of reproduction in an informal way.
- To reinforce the role of parents as a source of information on matters pertaining to sexuality and reproduction.

- To provide information on puberty for 10-13 year olds, in relation to the physical changes and emotional changes (in particular, helping them feel comfortable about their bodies and its functions; preparing them for the changes during puberty and dispelling the myths and providing accurate, understandable information).
- . To help young people feel okay about being different. Everyone develops at a different rate, especially during puberty.
- To confirm their individuality and promote self-esteem.
- To facilitate communication between parents and their children and encourage young people to take their questions, problems and concerns to their parents.

FULL DAY PROGRAM!

A full day program is offered with a variety of activities in **addition** to featured incursions and excursions. Programs are displayed daily.

How to book

- · Visit our website and click on Vacation Care
- · Complete the Booking Request Form
- The team will contact you via email to confirm your booking
- If your child has never attended Star Club before, you will need to enrol them first, before we can accept any booking.

What to bring

- Morning tea and lunch with accompanying drinks for the day. Breakfast (until 8am) and afternoon tea are provided. Please remember we are a NUT FREE service. Cooking experiences may be held during the day as additional meals.
- Jumper, hat, enclosed shoes, water bottle, spare change of clothes. Children must wear closed shoes but can bring open shoes for suitable activities.
- A big smile!

What to do each day

- Drop your child via the Page St gate.
- · Advise staff if your child will be absent by emailing the office
- Adhere to our health policy by keeping unwell children at home
- Dress your child in comfortable 'play' clothes suitable for active and sometimes messy activities.
- · Label all items (clothing, bag, hat, water bottle etc.)
- Notify us of any changes to allergy/health requirements for your child
- Collect your child by 6.00pm to avoid the late pick-up fee of \$15 per 15 minutes or part there of
- Email the office if your authorised contacts/pick-up persons have changed
- Pick up your child via the Page St gate. There is a sign at the gate with a phone number if the gate is unattended.

Weather Conditions

If rain is light, excursions may still be attended. Some activities may be cancelled at late notice if weather conditions are adverse. Families will be notified via email. Alternate activities will be provided if an excursion is cancelled.

Daily Activity

Activities may be changed or cancelled at the last minute due to circumstances beyond our control. In this situation, we will endeavour to provide a suitable replacement and notify parents

Group size & ratio

Anticipated # of children is 50-90 and # of staff is 4-9. Star Club's guideline is a 1:15 educator to child ratio and can range from 1:12 to 1:8 for excursions. For exact numbers refer to excursion information and roster on display.

Safety, supervision, transport & risk assessments

Star Club have strict safety and supervision procedures and policies, which are available to view onsite or on request. The children are encouraged to actively work with educators to implement these and follow all safety guidelines. Risk assessments have been prepared for all incursions and excursions, including transportation, and are available to view onsite or on request, as is our Covid-19 Risk Management Plan.

Behaviour

As per Star Club policy, Star Club reserves the right to exclude a child from the program if they demonstrate repeated unacceptable behaviour or behaviour which may pose a safety risk to others.

Money/belongings

Please do not allow your child to bring money, electronic devices, bikes or scooters to vacation care. They may only be brought if specified as part of the program. Star Club and its staff are not responsible for personal possessions if children choose to bring them to the service.

Cost & Child Care Subsidy

Daily fees are as listed. Enrolment fees are additional. All daily fees may be discounted through the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) system, if eligible. If it has not been done already, you must submit a Complying Written Agreement for your child(ren)'s Pagewood Public School Xplor profile, then confirm the enrolment in your MyGov/Centrelink account.

Payment method

Direct Debit is the ONLY method of payment available. Your Direct Debit information must be updated in your Xplor online account (home.myxplor.com) before a booking can be confirmed and accounts at all services must be up to date.

Within 24 hours of session = additional \$5 per child Walk-ins without confirmed booking = additional \$20 per child
