PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

Welcome back to Term 2! I hope students and their families have enjoyed a lovely break. There are many exciting learning opportunities to look forward to this term both in the classroom and beyond. Excursions are planned for Stage 1 and preparations are underway for the Stage 3 overnight excursion in Term 3. We are hoping some of the usual performing arts opportunities will be available for our bands, dance groups and choir.

Tomorrow students will return to school in winter uniform. Winter uniform is worn Monday to Thursday during Terms 2 and 3 and sports uniform on Fridays. The embroidered sport shorts or trackpants should be worn only on Fridays. As part of correct uniform, all children should wear the full Pagewood school uniform including jacket and school hat. This learning has included how to reflect on and implement evidence based reading practices, with an understanding of the necessary components of effective instruction and how this looks in the classroom and the resources required.

Teachers of Year 3-6 classes and School Learning Support Officers were led by Mrs Cianciolo, Mrs McLean, Miss Wilkinson and Miss Grisanti looking at effective mathematics for numeracy development and planning as well as how to implement and reflect on differentiated instruction for groups of students. Both of these professional learning opportunities will continue across the remainder of Term 2.

Professional learning for our School Administrative Staff, Jody and Orla, included modules to develop their skills in student management and wellbeing within our school based software programs. Frank was involved in professional learning about the role he will have on Fridays as our School Administrative Officer.

The professional learning that our staff undertake supports the Strategic Directions of the school as well as their own performance and development goals.

UPGRADE TO THE PARENT ONLINE PAYMENTS (POP) PAGE

We are now a 'cash free' school. Therefore, we encourage parents and carers to use our **new** Parent Online Payment (POP) system which will minimise disruptions to class time and save time for our staff.

The upgraded POP page replaces the old Westpac page. It's accessible from the school's website and allows parents and carers to make online payments anywhere and anytime. By using the upgraded page, parents and carers will enjoy:

- a quick and simple user interface;
- mobile-friendly experience – making it easier to pay via phone or tablet (as well as from a desktop computer); and
- multilingual support which enables them to use POP in their preferred language.
- Easily without needing to log on, register or enter a Student Registration Number.
- Check your email for a copy of your receipt

The anticipated increase in online payments will help to relieve the administrative burden on teachers and office staff. Additionally, schools will benefit from improved data quality, with the POP upgrades making it easier to reconcile payments with individual students.
