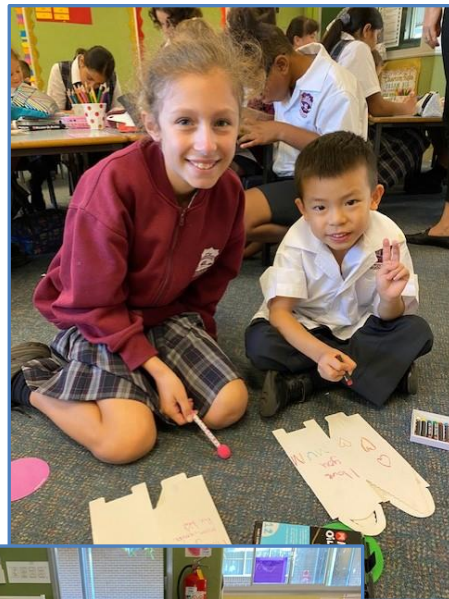
Out of area applications may be made through our school website (as above) with one or more of the below criteria in priority order to be addressed:

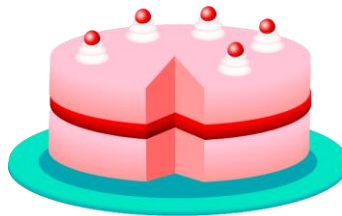
