UPGRADE TO THE PARENT ONLINE PAYMENTS (POP) PAGE

We are now a 'cash free' school. Therefore, we encourage parents and carers to use our <u>new</u> Parent Online Payment (POP) system which will minimise disruptions to class time and save time for our staff.

The upgraded POP page replaces the old Westpac page. It's accessible from the school's website and allows parents and carers to make online payments anywhere and anytime. By using the upgraded page, parents and carers will enjoy:

- a quick and simple user interface;
- mobile-friendly experience making it easier to pay via phone or tablet (as well as from a desktop computer); and
- multilingual support which enables them to use POP in their preferred language.
- Easily without needing to log on, register or enter a Student Registration Number.
- Check your email for a copy of your receipt

The anticipated increase in online payments will help to relieve the administrative burden on teachers and office staff. Additionally, schools will benefit from improved data quality, with the POP upgrades making it easier to reconcile payments with individual students. On our website, go to "Make a Payment" and enter your child's details.

UNIFORM SHOP – FACE TO FACE

Our uniform shop is open onsite for face-to-face orders fortnightly. Our parent volunteers complete uniform orders on Tuesday mornings. Please bring completed Order Form or email your order by filling out a form (which can be downloaded from the school's website) and emailed to ppsuniform@hotmail.com. Alternatively, your child can deliver the completed form to the office.

Winter uniform is worn Monday to Thursday during Term 2 and 3 and sports uniform on Fridays. The embroidered sport shorts or track pants, should be worn only on Fridays. As part of correct uniform, all children must wear the full Pagewood school uniform including jacket and school cap. Navy socks are worn all week. It is important that shoes are all black in colour.
