STUDENT SCHOOL FEES

Thank you to those families who have paid their child's school fees. A reminder that student school fees for Term 1 are now overdue. Payment at your earliest convenience would be appreciated. The School Voluntary Contribution is \$50. This is a voluntary payment to the school. Parents are encouraged to pay all fees if possible before the Term 2 student school fees are sent home next term. Payments can still be accepted over the holidays.

We appreciate some parents may have difficulties meeting these costs. Please contact Ms Mayhew in confidence if you would like to discuss this matter.

YEAR 6 to YEAR 7 EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

The Online Enrolment System is a web-based system that supports the transition and enrolment of students in NSW government schools. Parents and carers are required to complete an EOI (Expression of Interest) for their child's preference to attend a government high school or submit a PNR (Placement Not Required) online if they do not require a placement in a government high school. You can express interest in your local high school or an out-of-area expression.

This is accessible from the Enrolment page on the Pagewood Public School website. Please complete a digital EOI for your Year 6 child noting which NSW government high school you enrol for them to attend. The high school will be based on your residential address. The online process will benefit parents and carers by providing a quick and easy way to apply for an EOI or advise of a PNR. Parents and carers will also receive a reference number along with a record of the online application. Once you submit your preference, school staff will then be able to review the information submitted and process EOIs and PNRs for high schools to view and action.

Online EOIs should be completed by 10 April.

FUN DAY

Year 5 and 6 will be holding a Fun Day for all school students this Wednesday 10 April from 1.30pm to 3.00pm. All students are welcome to participate. Prices for each activity range from \$1 - \$5. If you would like your child to participate we suggest bringing in approximately \$10-20 in gold coins to join in the many events on offer.
