### DECODABLE B.E.A.R. PROGRAM

The DECODABLE BEAR Program aims to give students an opportunity to improve their oral reading skills by providing extra reading practice.

This program is delivered by a volunteer tutor and monitored by both the student's classroom teacher and the Learning and Support Teacher.

Students participate in the program two times per week for half an hour each session.

We are looking for volunteers to listen to students in mainly Years 1 and 2 then play a few simple word games with them. Most volunteers take two students, but one is good as well.

This is a great opportunity to learn how to discuss a reader with a child and listen to them read the decodable texts.

I can run training sessions on Monday at 2.45pm to 3.15pm or I can organise another time if this isn't suitable.

## Athletics Field Events

Last Thursday, students turning 8 years and older participated in shot put and high jump at school. An additional session for the Juniors (8, 9 and 10yrs) is required to finalise these events. This will take place on Thursday July 4th. **Junior students may wear their sports uniform and appropriate footwear on this day**. Any 11 or 12 year old students who missed out on shot put will complete this in their usual PE lesson (no need to wear sport uniform). Once these events are finalised, students who have qualified for the Zone Athletics Carnival will be notified.

### Premier's Sporting Challenge

We are now into the final week of the Premier's Sporting Challenge. All students in Years 3-6 have been provided with their log in details and shown how to record their daily physical activity through the online platform, '10 Week Challenge Activity Tracker'. Any students in Years 3-6 completing the challenge will receive a personalised certificate (Diamond, Gold, Silver or Bronze), signed by the Premier of New South Wales. All students in K-2 will work towards a 'Gold' class award level. K-2 students' physical activity will be recorded by their classroom teacher.

The following is an outline of what is required to achieve each award level:

- Bronze 30 minutes of physical activity per day
- Silver 45 minutes of physical activity per day
- Gold 60 minutes of physical activity per day
- Diamond 80 minutes of physical activity per day

## HEALTHY LUNCHBOXES - SWAP IT LUNCHBOX PROGRAM

SWAP IT is an award winning school health and wellbeing program supporting parents and carers to swap what is packed in the lunchbox from **sometimes foods** to **everyday foods**.



SWAP IT has been developed by university researchers with expertise in child health, nutrition and education and psychology. SWAP IT aligns with many NSW Health and

Education policies that guide how we provide wellbeing support to our students and our community.

Did you know.....that the food children consume is linked to their ability to concentrate, learn and achieve academically.

Did you know....improving child nutrition can lead to enhanced academic outcomes, concentration, mental and physical wellbeing.

Therefore lunchboxes matter! A third of what your child eats each day comes from the lunchbox. When a lunchbox includes too many sometimes foods, a child may not get the nutrition they need to thrive. One swap from a sometimes food to an everyday food can make a difference.

SWAP IT is effective and free. We hope all of our families get on board with this SWAP IT program to educate our students and help them thrive by making small changes to student lunchboxes. **Please chat with your child/ren about sometimes foods and everyday foods.**


